



Guide for Authors

Scientific Interdisciplinary – A Grantsculpt Publication

1. Manuscript Submission

Authors must submit their manuscripts through the online submission system available on the *Scientific Interdisciplinary* journal website. Manuscripts should be prepared according to the guidelines outlined below.

2. Article Types

We accept the following types of articles:

- **Original Research Articles:** Comprehensive reports of new research findings.
- **Review Articles:** Summaries of existing research with critical analysis.
- **Short Communications:** Brief reports of significant developments.
- **Perspectives and Opinions:** Insights on emerging trends and future directions.

3. Manuscript Preparation

3.1. General Formatting

- Use **12-point Times New Roman** font, double-spaced text.
- Submit in **Microsoft Word (.docx)** or **LaTeX (.tex)** format.
- Number all pages and use line numbers for easy review.
- Include figures and tables in the main text or as separate files.

3.2. Structure

A typical manuscript should be structured as follows:

- **Title Page:** Title, authors' names, affiliations, corresponding author's contact details.

- **Abstract** (250 words max): Brief summary highlighting objectives, methodology, results, and conclusions.
- **Keywords**: Provide 4-6 keywords for indexing.
- **Introduction**: Background, significance, and objective of the study.
- **Materials and Methods**: Detailed methodology for reproducibility.
- **Results**: Concise reporting of findings with figures and tables.
- **Discussion**: Interpretation of results, comparison with previous studies.
- **Conclusion**: Summary of findings and future outlook.
- **References**: Use **style** as described in section 5. citation style, as specified.

4. Figures and Tables

- Figures should be high-resolution (300 dpi or higher).
- Tables must be editable (not images) and include descriptive captions.
- Provide figure legends separately.

5. Citation and References

- Use reference management software (e.g., **EndNote, Mendeley**).
- Ensure all citations in text appear in the reference list and vice versa.
- **Reference Style for *Scientific Interdisciplinary***

Authors should ensure that all references are formatted consistently according to the following style:

(a) Journal Articles

Author(s), *Title*, **Journal Name**, **Volume**(*Issue*), Year, Page Range, DOI.

- Example:
Smith J., *Advances in High Entropy Alloys*, **Materials Science Journal**, **25**(4), 2023, 123-135, <https://doi.org/xxxxx>.

(b) Books

Author(s), *Book Title*, Edition (if applicable), Publisher, Year.

- Example:

Brown P., *Fundamentals of Surface Chemistry*, 2nd ed., Springer, 2020.

(c) Conference Proceedings

Author(s), *Title of Paper*, in *Proceedings of Conference Name*, Location, Year, Page Range.

- Example:

Lee K. and Chen M., *Nanomaterials for Energy Storage*, in *Proceedings of the International Conference on Advanced Materials*, Tokyo, 2022, pp. 45-50.

(d) Book Chapters

Author(s), *Chapter Title*, in *Book Title*, Ed(s). Editor Name(s), Publisher, Year, Page Range.

- Example:

White R., *Mechanochemical Processing of Materials*, in *Advanced Metallurgy*, Ed. Green T., Elsevier, 2021, pp. 89-110.

(e) Patents

Inventor(s), *Patent Title*, Patent Number, Year.

- Example:

Johnson L., *High-Performance Battery Electrodes*, US 10,123,456 B2, 2023.

(f) Reports and Theses

Author(s), *Title*, Report/Thesis Type, Institution, Year.

- Example:
Kumar S., *Lattice Distortion in High-Entropy Alloys*, Ph.D. Thesis, MIT, 2022.

(g) Online News and Websites

Author(s)/Organization, *Title*, Website Name, Date, URL (Accessed: Date).

- Example:
Nature News, *Breakthrough in Quantum Computing*, Nature, January 15, 2024, <https://www.nature.com/news> (Accessed: February 5, 2025).

6. Ethical Considerations

- Authors must follow ethical research practices and declare conflicts of interest.
- Studies involving human or animal subjects require ethical approval.
- Plagiarism and duplicate submission are strictly prohibited.

7. Peer Review Process

All submissions undergo a **double-blind peer review** process:

1. Initial screening for compliance with journal guidelines.
2. Assignment to expert reviewers.
3. Reviewer feedback and revision requests.
4. Final editorial decision based on revisions.

8. Copyright and Open Access

- Authors retain copyright but grant the journal a **license to publish**.
- *Scientific Interdisciplinary* follows an **open-access model**, ensuring free and global accessibility to published content.

9. Article Processing Charges (APC)

- There are **no submission fees**.
- APCs (if applicable) will be communicated upon acceptance.
